











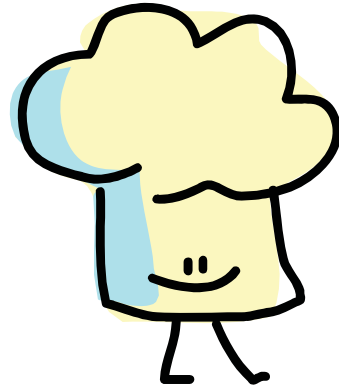


Decorate Your Chef's Hat!





Unleash Your Little Chef's Creativity

Let your favorite chef customize his or her hat with these creative craft ideas:

-  In addition to the sticky foam letters provided in class, seek out other foam shapes and characters at your local craft store.
-  Keep up the chef theme by gluing small lightweight kitchen utensils or plastic foods to the hat.
-  Add artificial flowers or leaves to the chef's hat.
-  Glitz up the hat with glitter or puffy paints.
-  Accessorize with ribbon, tulle, cording, or colored yarn.
-  Glue on beads or dazzle that cap with rhinestones.
-  For a whimsical touch, stick a few feathers in the cap.
-  Buttons, lace, and fabric can add a little uniqueness to the hat.
-  Use costume jewelry for a princess look.
-  Spray paint the hat to show off your child's favorite colors.



Decorating Tips for Parents

-  Let your child choose the theme or decorations for his or her own hat.
-  Look for self-adhesive embellishments at your local craft store to make decorating the chef's hat easy for your child.
-  Only parents should use a low heat glue gun to attach ribbons, beads, rhinestones, and other objects to the hat. Let your child supervise the work!
-  Purchase glue dots to allow your child to attach buttons and other objects safely to the hat.
